



INTERNATIONAL REMOTE SECOND OPINION PROGRAM

The Children's National Global Services Division has treated thousands of patients and families from around the world seeking our renowned clinical care team.

The Global Services Division features a dedicated team experienced in providing world-class services to international patients and families seeking a remote second opinion or medical care in the United States.

Our International Remote Second Opinion (RSO) Program provides families and patients access to leading pediatric specialists at Children's National Hospital, so they can be informed of their options prior to deciding on the child's care - without ever having to travel outside of their home country.

For each RSO, the appropriate physician reviews all the patient's medical information, including any radiology and pathology reports, and compiles their findings into a comprehensive written report that is shared directly with the patient and their family.

The RSO fee starts at US \$1,000, and it can increase based on the number of specialties and if a video consultation is requested. If diagnosis involves a pathology reading, a Children's National pathologist will review the submitted slides, and additional fees can occur.



OUR PROGRAM OFFERS:

- Direct access to the program's designated clinical intake team to assist you through the process
- Online submission of clinical information and radiologic films
- Medical review by pediatric specialists
- Comprehensive written medical second opinion reports
- Video conferences between Children's National specialists and home referring physicians to discuss RSOs*
- Post-opinion follow-up and assistance with referrals

HOW IT WORKS

The following information provides an overview of our easy 3-step process to refer a child.

STEP 1:

REFERRING A PATIENT

Submit the patient's demographic and clinical information on the **International Patient Access Form**. To successfully complete the form, have the following information available:

- **Patient's demographic information**
- **Medical records in English** - We cannot accept medical records in other languages at this time.

Once the general demographic information is submitted, you will be directed to a secure page to upload medical reports in English. If you have imaging to share, our team will provide a link for transfer following the initial review.

STEP 2:

ASSIGNING AN EXPERT

The Global Services team will review the records and connect with the appropriate specialty team to assign an expert to render the opinion. Additional information will be requested as needed to provide valuable feedback.

STEP 3:

REVIEW OF MEDICAL INFORMATION

The Global Services team will provide the written report via email within 7-10 business days upon receipt of the required documentation and the RSO fee. If requested, we can schedule a provider-to-provider video consultation between the Children's National physician and the home referring physician.


